### MINIMUM HOURS & GPR REQUIREMENTS

- 120 hours required for this degree with a minimum overall GPR of 2.000.
- Students must complete a minimum of 36 hours of 300/400 level course work at Texas A&M.

### MAJOR FIELD OF STUDY

35 HOURS REQUIRED.

A minimum GPR of 2.0 must be maintained in all PSYC courses. A total of 35 hours of Psychology courses are required, with a maximum combined total of 6 hours of PSYC 484, 485, 485H, 491, or 491H (see advisor). You may not receive 484, 485, 491 credit for paid internships. Courses in Psychology **cannot** be used to meet any other requirements for this degree plan. No grade below a "C" is acceptable in the major field of study.
